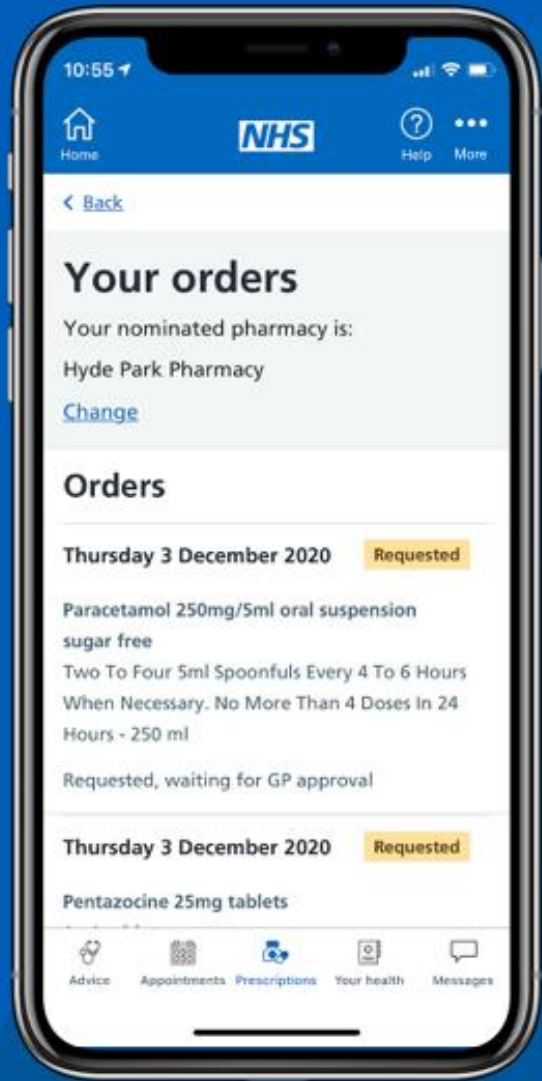

# HOW TO ORDER YOUR MEDICATION VIA THE WEBSITE:

1. Go to <https://www.peartreegp.co.uk/>
2. Select 'Prescriptions'
3. Then select 'Repeat Prescription Online Request'
4. Complete the form including which pharmacy you would like the prescription sent to
5. You can also sign up to the online service. Just pop into the surgery with some ID to receive a username and password

## HOW TO ORDER YOUR MEDICATION USING THE NHS APP:

1. *Log into your NHS account using the NHS App or NHS Website*
2. Select 'Order A Repeat Prescription'
3. On the 'Prescriptions' page, select 'Order a Repeat Prescription'
4. Confirm your nominated pharmacy
5. On the 'Select Medication' page, select the checkbox for the medications required, then select 'Continue'
6. Free text the medication you require if not on your repeat record
7. You should see a confirmation page of the medications requested, check details and then select 'Confirm and Order Prescription'

# TALK TO YOUR LOCAL PHARMACY



YOUR PHARMACY CAN REQUEST YOUR MEDICATION ON YOUR BEHALF. PLEASE LET THEM KNOW WHAT YOU REQUIRE

TICK THE MEDICATION REQUIRED IN THE CHECKBOX ON A REPEAT REQUEST SLIP AND HAND IT INTO YOUR PHARMACY

PLEASE NOTE YOUR PHARMACY WILL NEED YOUR CONSENT TO ORDER YOUR MEDICATION FROM YOUR GP

# ELECTRONIC REPEAT DISPENSING (eRD)

- If you are stable on your regular medication and up to date with blood tests and medication reviews, you may be eligible for eRD
- This means your GP can send your repeat prescriptions electronically to your nominated pharmacy for up to 6 months.
- You can then collect your medication each month from your pharmacy without having to request a prescription

Electronic repeat dispensing is a reliable, secure and confidential NHS service. Unlike paper prescriptions, electronic prescriptions can't get lost between the doctor and the pharmacy
